Poster Video Instructions for Participants:

- Create a video that showcases your (AI-related) work. The video should be approximately 2-3 minutes long.
- The following links give some ideas on what to include in your poster video, as well as some general tips for online presentations, but feel free to use your preferred tools..
 - a. Building a video presentation with Powerpoint
 - b. How to record a presentation with Webcam, Narration, and more
 - c. <u>Different software for video presentation</u>
- Upload your video on youtube (requires Google account). Please ensure that the video permissions are set to "public".
- In the description of the video, you can add more details such as a short abstract, links to papers or a web site with more info.
- After uploading the video, fill in the following <u>Google Form</u>, where you should submit the author name(s), email, affiliation, video link, title, and a short abstract.
- During the poster sessions, you need to be online to interact with other participants via the comments section of your Youtube video. This would be a good place to facilitate a discussion about your project by replying to their comments in the thread that they created. It is also important to check the comments from time to time throughout the week, as participants may post questions outside the poster session hours.
